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Cadet Transportation Permission Form

The Staff and Support Committee of The Queen's York Rangers 2799 Army Cadet Corps ("the Corps") often provide transportation for cadets to and from their home communities for and during training, fundraising and community service activities. This includes activities at the Corps' regular Local Headquarters (LHQ) at the Aurora Armoury as well as other locations per Unit Routine Orders, Warning Orders, Training Schedules and Calendars. Permission is required by parent/guardians of all cadets BEFORE the cadet is permitted to take advantage of ANY transportation arranged by the Corps.

Please read and sign below.

- a. Be aware that there is risk involved with riding buses and vehicles provided by the Corps;
- b. The parent has a choice whether to allow their son, daughter or ward to ride in any vehicle;
- c. The Corps is NOT able to provide adult supervision other than the driver of the bus or vehicle, but does task the most senior cadet on a bus to maintain order and discipline;
- d. Cadets are expected to be respectful and well-behaved at all times. Riding in a bus or vehicle is a privilege and failure to follow the rules of the Bus Company, Driver and/or Corps will result in an immediate loss of these privileges;
- e. The Army Cadet League of Canada provides insurance that covers all cadets participating during ALL cadet activities including while travelling in vehicles provided by the Corps;
- f. All School Bus Drivers and Support Committee Members are screened by completing a Police Records Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening (PRC/VSS);
- g. Volunteers who occasionally drive cadets during activities are NOT screened; and
- h. At all times indemnify and save harmless any officer, civilian instructor, volunteer, support committee member, servant, agent, employee and member of the Army Cadet League of Canada and the Department of National Defence from and against all claims and demands, loss, costs, damages, actions, causes of action, suits or other proceedings by whomsoever made, brought or prosecuted in a manner, related to any loss, property damage, personal injury or death, resulting from, occasioned by or attributable in any way to riding in a bus or vehicle provided by the Corps.
